Dr. Jones is the 17th oncologist to join CCNC, making it the Triangle's largest group of cancer physicians in private practice.

Dr. Jones has practiced oncology and gynecologic oncology and surgery at the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine in Rochester, MN. For five years she served as an assistant professor for the departments of obstetrics, gynecology and general surgery at the Mayo Clinic.

Dr. Jones' arrival augments CCNC's wide-ranging service offerings, which encompasses treatments for all adult cancers including solid tumors, leukemia, lymphoma and head and neck cancers. Dr. Jones has a special interest in the treatment of ovarian cancer.

She is board-certified in general obstetrics and gynecology



and gynecologic oncology.

Dr. Jones is the recipient of numerous awards and honors for teaching and research, as well as a frequent presenter at research meetings. She is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a member of the International Gynecologic Cancer Society and the education committee of the Society of Gynecologic Oncologists.
